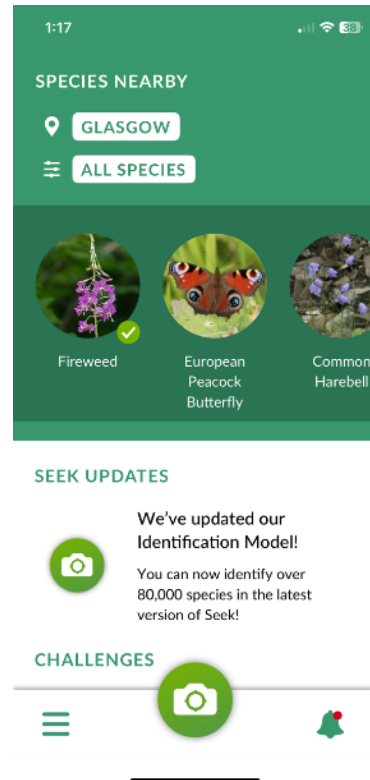


How to link your Seek app to iNaturalist

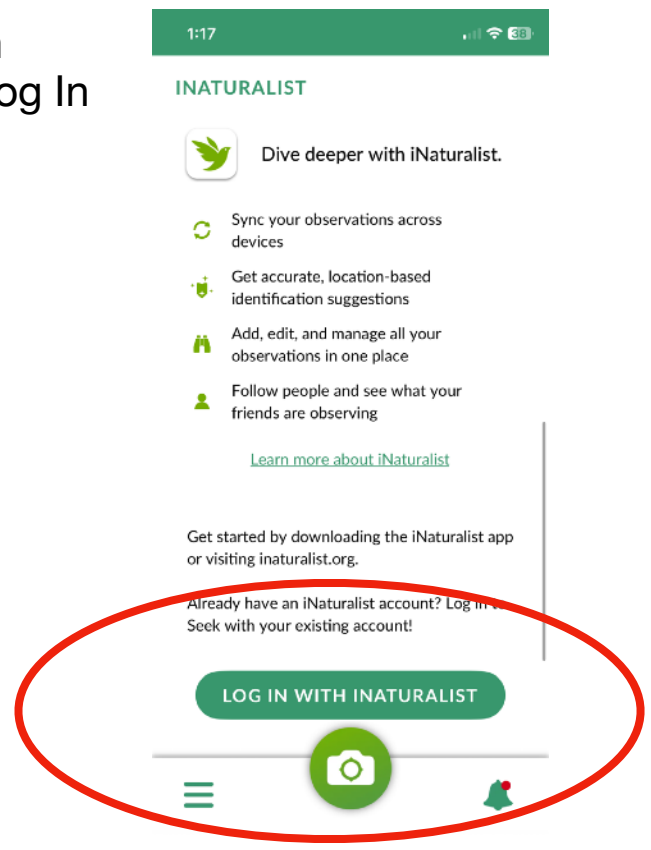
If you decide to download iNaturalist and get a login for it, you can choose whether to upload any of the observations you make with Seek to it.

1. Open the Seek app to the home page

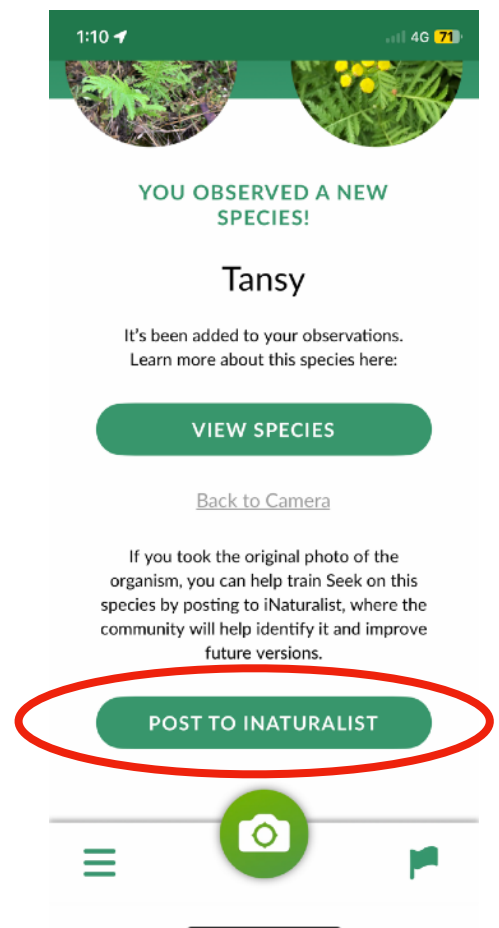


2. Scroll down to the section on iNaturalist and click the green “Log In with iNaturalist” button.

This will let you enter your login



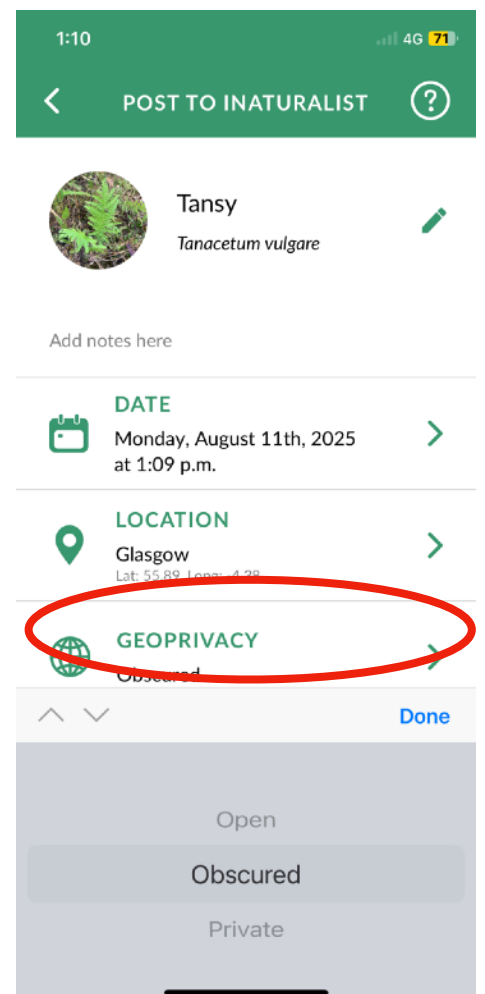
3. Now when you observe a species you can click a button to post it to iNaturalist



4. Before sending the post you have to confirm some details. One thing you might want to change is the **Geoprivacy** setting

If it's **Open** anyone on iNaturalist can see where you took the photo.



If you'd prefer to hide your location from other users of the iNaturalist app (but not the scientists using the data) click on **Geoprivacy** and choose **Obscured**.




5. You're now ready to click **Post to iNaturalist** to confirm the submission with obscured Geoprivacy.
