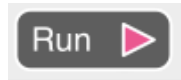


Live code your own DJ set!

Mexican Roulette is a way of live coding with friends invented at an Algorave.

Instead of making all the changes to a piece of code yourself, put on a pair of headphones connected to a splitter and **get some friends** to do the same. This will let you **all** hear what's happening.

1. Start the piece by clicking



2. The first person changes something in the code, e.g.

- A synth
- A sample
- An effect
- A number

Then clicks the **Run** button again to see what the piece sounds like with the change

3. Then the next person changes another thing and presses



4. Keep doing this until you've had enough music and want to move on!

Note: It's possible that any change could make the music sound awful or crash, but that's **easily fixed**:

Press **Ctrl-Z** to **undo the last change** and click **Run** again
